- Student Internships in businesses in collaboration with India SME Forum are to be launched in a pilot project in seven states i.e. Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Punjab and West Bengal.
- Student Internships are being offered by the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) field organization in district-level offices with two slots per district in the country.
- Student Police Internships with the State Governments.

Internship programmes will provide hands-on experience in work situations to regular students of Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs). Such internships would be very valuable for experiential learning in real-life work situations and students who avail of these internship opportunities, would benefit from the same.

Madam/Sir,

Your kind attention is drawn to the subject mentioned above and to say that Department of Youth Affairs, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports has proposed "Student Internship Scheme" for undergraduate and postgraduate student. It has been stated that recently, the University Grants Commission has introduced a circular for earning a minimum of two credits by students of Higher Education, who undertake internship and these credits will be part of the marks-sheet of the student. Department of Youth Affairs is mandated to equip the youth with cognitive skills and people skills through experiential learning, with a view to improving their employability. Currently they are implementing the Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS) and National Service Scheme (NSS) in pursuance of this objective & has emphasized that, proposed internship would be another step in harnessing the energies of youth in an appropriate direction. The programme has been proposed to be administered jointly by the NSS/NYKS in coordination with the Police Department at local level.

2. "Police" is a State subject falling in List-II (State List) of the VII Schedule of the Constitution of India. However, it is requested that the State Police organisations might consider the proposal of D/o Youth Affairs along with NSS/NYKS for implementing this "Student Internship Scheme" as per extant Rules/ guidelines applicable (of the respective States).
